1

Choose your Brunel course and apply on the Brunel website

When completing your application, include all your grades and course information (including the modules you're studying) and university education history so that we have everything we need to assess your application and come back to you with a decision. If you're using an international advisor, ask them to do this for you.

Congratulations, you've been made a conditional offer to study at Brunel!

You will receive an email from us confirming the outcome of your application.

Relax. We're working hard on assessing your application so there's no need to do anything unless we contact you for more information

We'll email you if:

- We need further information in order to assess your application
- Your application has been referred to the academic department for further review
- Your course requires a Skype interview, or you need to submit a portfolio

Make your decision

Read your offer email carefully, and consider this offer along with any other offer you receive to decide which is the right course and university for you.

Accept your offer

Once you have decided to accept your offer, simply log into the [MyApplications portal](#) and accept your offer. If you have an international advisor, they can do this for you.

Apply for funding in your own country

Apply for accommodation on campus

You can apply for accommodation at Brunel as soon as you've received an offer, but you won't be able to book anything until your offer becomes unconditional. No need to worry though, all international students are guaranteed on campus accommodation at Brunel throughout their postgraduate degree!

Meet the conditions of your offer

You'll need to meet the conditions by the deadline given in your offer email before we can issue you with a CAS number (you need this for your Visa application). These may include:

- Uploading evidence of the qualifications you have completed on [MyApplications portal](#)
- Applying for your [ATAS certificate](#) and uploading a copy to [MyApplications portal](#) (only required for some courses)
- Completing a [Length of Study form](#)
- Paying your [course deposit](#)

Apply for a Visa

You'll need a [Tier 4 \(general\) Student Visa](#) to study in the UK. Once you've met all the conditions of your offer, we will provide you with a CAS number which you can use to apply for your Visa. Please note, we can only issue this three months before your course starts.

Book your accommodation

Once your offer has been made unconditional, you can select your accommodation and pay the deposit. Find out more about our [on-campus accommodation](#).

Complete online registration task 1

This is first stage of registration. Simply log into [MyApplications portal](#) and complete the registration task assigned to you.

Book your airport pick up

We'll send you all the details you need. If you have an international advisor, they can help you with booking this.

Sign up for International Orientation Week

We'll send you all the details you need. If you have an international advisor, they can help you with booking this.

14

Complete registration task 2 on campus
